The profeft caufe of Erafmus leaving Eugband about this time, was to attend the Prefs at Bafil, where be chofe to bave his Books pablifh'd under the care of Froben the Printer. In the preceeding Year we have an Epiftle indeed of his to Gonell: dated in 1515 . in words at length in the London Edition, and yer the matter determines it to have been in the former Year. For in the beginning of $\mathcal{F u l y} 1514$. he was got over to Hamme Cafle near Calice. from whence he wrote to Servatius ${ }^{b}$ that be had not left England, for want of encouragement; for the King, and Bihop Wolley bis prine favourite, bad promis'd bim mighty matters: but he muft go to Bafil to publifh bis Lucubrations. Upon the fame 8th of fuly 1514. he wrote to his Friend And. Ammonius* in London, gave him an account of his fafe Voyage, that bowever he had the misfortune of
